OVERVIEW

The Emergency Food Distribution Program (TEFAP) provides food (dry goods, canned meats, vegetables, fruits, juices, etc.) to Baltimore City families with incomes between 0 - 150% of the Poverty Guidelines. The Human Services Division (HSD) utilizes approximately 148 locations including: Human Services HUBs, Churches, and other public/private organizations that serve as the TEFAP Distribution Centers.

PROGRAM SUMMARY

*In FY '94, The Emergency Food Assistance Program will serve over 160,000 low-income families.

*In the last quarter of FY '93 (August - September) the Distribution Centers served over 33,000 eligible families that received 70,500 pounds of food.

*TEFAP is projecting to serve over 41,000 families in the 1st quarter of Fiscal Year 1994 beginning January, 1994.

**The FY '94 TEFAP Distribution Cycle will not begin until mid-January, 1994. In an effort to reduce overall administrative, and operational costs, the October - December food distribution cycle has been discontinued per State mandate.

Mental Health professionals have long seen the need for preschool children to have a place where they can develop in a safe environment. To this end the children of the Children's Hours have been recruited. It is our thought that if we could have gentle, loving people to work with children in this preschool age bracket, it would make a difference in their development.

The Children's Hours is a values's clarification program designed to help children ages three to five in the areas of self-esteem, creative expression, self-discipline and socialization skill development. Funding for this program was provided for this current fiscal year by Saint Agnes Hospital.

The program officially began on Thursday, March 17th. It is being held in Room Seven at Saint Benedict's School, located at 2612 Wilkens Avenue. Sessions are held on Thursdays and Fridays each week from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 noon. Current enrollment is limited to ten children. At this point in time we have ten children enrolled.

Recruitment for the Spring, 1994, session was held during January and February, 1994, in the COIL area. Contacts were made with community leaders. Requests were made to these community leaders for help in recruitment for the program. Flyers were designed and distributed in the area.

There seemed to be an interest on the part of some community leaders in helping the program get started.

The Spring, 1994 program ended on Friday, May 20th. Eight children attended the last session. The Summer program will begin on Thursday, June 2nd, 1994, at 9:00 a.m. Letters were sent to the current participants for participation in the summer, 1994 session. We are very interested in involving as many children as possible in the program.
