#### INTRODUCTION

This statistical report has been prepared by the Baltimore County Office of Planning and Zoning from U. S. Census data. It is intended as an interim report to provide population information in demand by governmental agencies, schools, industries and various civic organizations.

#### Baltimore County, Its Size and Number of Census Tracts

Baltimore County nearly surrounds, but does not include Baltimore City. Its 610 square miles are divided into 15 election districts which are significant primarily for statistical and administrative purposes. All but the 3 northern election districts were divided into 67 census tracts for the 1950 U. S. Census. Because of the rapid growth in the following 10 years, the 67 census tracts and 3 election districts were again divided into 126 census tracts for the 1960 census. None of the boundaries of the original census tracts have been changed; however, the election district lines were changed slightly by the Baltimore County Council in 1959.

#### More Detailed Population Report in 1962


The United States Bureau of the Census now expects to have available by late 1962 more detailed population data. Soon thereafter the Baltimore County Office of Planning and Zoning plans to publish a comprehensive analysis of Baltimore County's population, its characteristics and growth trends.

#### Pertinent Census Tract Information

1960 census tracts are designated by a six digit number which indicates: the election district in which the tract lies, the tract number used in the 1950 census, and the subdivision of the 1950 tract to create the 1960 census tract.


The 1960 census tract numbering system is as follows:




