Pay Roll of Capt. Adam Barnes's Company M.D.
militia Drafted in the U.S. service. (32d Regt.)

(NOTE: All of these men joined the detachment at Bills' tavern, marched three days and arrived at Annapolis on the 18th April, 1813---45 miles. The distance of residence from Bills tavern to home of each soldier in miles is given---also pay of each.)
