(31 August, 1814.)

MUSTER ROLL of a company of INFANTRY under the command of of ANDREW E. WARNER in the THIRTY NINTH REGIMENT of MARYLAND MILITIA, commanded by Lt. Col. BENJAMIN FOWLER, now in the service of the UNITED STATES from the 31 day of AUGUST, 1814, when first mustered, to the 18th day of October, 1814, WHEN LAST MUSTERED:
