All of the following soldiers entered on service 22d July and served 3 days--were discharged 24 July--Rations retained for lieut. 9, value of Rations retained 1.20 for Lieut. Rations retained for Ensign--value of rations returned \$1.20---The Pay for Lieut was 2.95 and his total was 4.15---The Pay for Ensign was \$1.98 total 3.18. For the 1st Sergt, Rations retained, 3, value 60¢, his pay was 1.09, total 1.69---For Corporal Rations retained 3, Value 60 ¢ Pay 99 total 1.59. For Privates rations retained 3, value 60, pay 79. total \$1.39.
