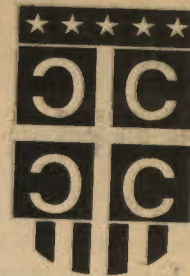

## Serbian American Days In Washington

— JULY 22, 23 & 24, 1990 —

WASHINGTON, D.C. — An exciting new event has been planned for late July in our nation's capitol. The Serbs, who are known for their energetic choral festivals, convivial sporting tournaments, and gregarious assemblies of every type, are turning their attention to the socio-political arena in Washington, D.C. The event is called simply "Serbian American Days in Washington" and will be headquartered in the prestigious Hyatt Regency Washington on Capitol Hill on July 22, 23 and 24, 1990. The honorary chairwoman, Helen Delich Bentley, and announced that co-sponsors of this affair are the American Serbian Heritage Foundation and the Serbian American Voters Association PAC of Los Angeles, California.

The first day of scheduled events, Sunday, July 22, is dedicated to a stimulating presentation of morning and afternoon symposiums in the hotel regarding Serbia's historical heritage. The lectures will be delivered in English by noted academicians such as Dr. Milos Velimirovich of the University of Virginia, Dr. Alex N. Dragnich of Vanderbilt University, and Dr. Dimitrije Djordjevich of the University of California, Santa Barbara, to name but a few. Participation from the audience will be encouraged. Some of the topics to be discussed will be Serbia's Cultural Legacy, Serbia's Resistance to Ottoman Penetration, and Serbia; Ally of the West in Two World Wars. Sunday evening will be climaxed by a gala cocktail reception and banquet at the hotel honoring those Serbian Americans who have made outstanding contributions to their community and nation. There also will be surprise guests from Serbia.

Monday, July 23 will feature political seminars in

the Rayburn Building on Capitol Hill, concerning legislative updates, lobbying techniques, and Serbian issues updates conducted by Congresswoman Bentley, and other professionals. After luncheon, a presentation will be made about many Serbian Americans who have distinguished themselves in the United States. On Monday evening from 5:30 to 8:00 p.m., members of Congress will be the honored guests at a cocktail reception in the Rayburn Gold Room. Here another opportunity will be offered to present the Serbian viewpoint accompanied by the usual Serbian hospitality.

Tuesday, July 24 is devoted to lobbying Members of the House and Senate in person and in their legislative offices! We Serbs are inexperienced in this activity, but we learned a few months ago how effective calling and writing our legislators can be. We need to contact members of the Human Rights Caucus, the Holocaust Museum, and the Helsinki Commission with our concerns and our points of view. The world press is not sympathetic with the Serbian perspective as yet, but we can make changes occur by speaking out the truth assertively in Washington, writing to newspaper editors, and interfacing frequently with our elected representatives on state and national levels.

Committee planners led by Congresswoman Bentley are hoping that Serbs from every state will descend on Washington to participate in this vigorous new activity. Come see your old friends and make new ones. Stay a day or two longer for sightseeing. Washington is a tourist's paradise! For information on where to register, see the accompanying ad.

Slobodan Jovich of St. George's in Duluth (Gary), Minn.; Rev. Ninkovich of the St. Paul-Minneapolis area. Invitations have been extended to Proto Bronko Skaljic of Parma, Ohio, who had served St. Vasilije in the early 50's. Also, Rev. Ratsko Trbuhovich of Lackawanna, N.Y., whose father the late Proto Mladen Trbuhovich, and the grandfather, the late Proto Dushan, served the St. Vasilije Church.
