Један од првих и врло активних покровитеља и помагача Сабора Српског Уједињења био је блаженопочивши Кнез Андреја Карађорђевић.

Ово је изванредна прилика да се помогне српским интересима и да установимо једно тело које ће моћи да се супротстави многим антисрпским сентиментима и покретима у свету...Опет, дозволи ми да истакнем да ја верујем да се коначно започело нешто, стварно вредно и такође верујем да би ти требало да учествујеш у томе.»

Седмог маја Кнез Андреја је преминуо.

Нека му Бог пода вечни мир и спокојство а нама снагу и вољу да наставимо путем честитог и племенитог Кнеза свих Срба.

Among early Sponsors and very active supporters of the Serbian Unity Congress was the late Prince Andrej.

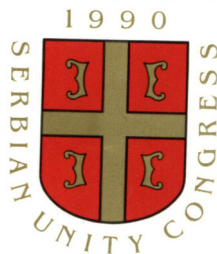
As all Serbs, the Sponsors of the Congress are deeply grieved by this irreplaceable loss. His untimely death has affected our Serbian cause.

On May 3, 1990, Prince Andrej wrote and invited one of many prominent Serbs to help the Serbian Unity Congress in this manner:

"Today, I want once again to ask you about joining the Serbian Congress. It will be an excellent opportunity to support our Serbian cause and to be an instrument to counter the numerous anti-Serb sentiments and movements around the world... Once again let me say that I believe we have finally gotten something really worthwhile started and further believe you should be a part of it."

On May 7, 1990, Prince Andrej passed away.

May God grant Him peace and may we be granted strength and will to continue carrying on the same struggle this noble dedicated Prince of all the Serbs fought for to His very end.

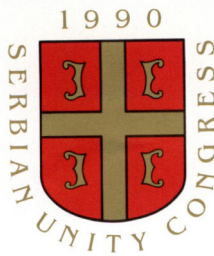

Dear Mr. Swihart:

As we mentioned to you during our recent visit in Washington, a Mission of Friendship and Goodwill will be leaving for Serbia on March 22, 1991.

With the exception of two members from Australia and one from Mexico, the Mission is composed of prominent Americans of Serbian origin (see list attached).

The official work of the Mission will end on April 4, 1991.

On the first two days, Monday, March 25th and Tuesday, March 26th, the Mission will be paying courtesy visits in Belgrade to His Holiness, Patriarch Paul, President Milosevic and the leaders of the Majority/Minority in the Serbian Parliament. However, as indicated to you, we would like to have our first visit with Ambassador Zimmermann and his staff. This should be early on Monday, March 25th.

The purpose of this visit will be to receive a first-hand update from Ambassador Zimmermann on the situation in Yugoslavia. Moreover, we would welcome any constructive help and suggestions he and his staff may offer to assist our objectives.

These objectives, as we stated to you, primarily include ascertaining the factual conditions in Serbia in the key sectors of social life. In addition to the five sectors -- Health Care, Education, Small Business, Agriculture and Public Media -- five key institutions have been singled out for visits and analyses. These institutions are: the Church, the Government, Parliament, Serbian Academy of Letters and Science, and Matica Isejjenika.

Upon its return to the United States, the Mission will consolidate all analyses and offer a concrete plan as to how best we can assist Serbia in expansion and promotion of civil liberties, free market, economic progress and democracy in general.

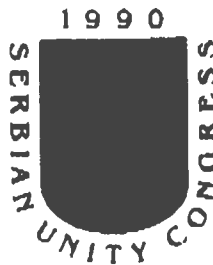
