## SERBIA DOESN'T DESERVE MOST-FAVORED-NATION STATUS

Dear Colleague:

Later this week I will be introducing legislation to remove most-favored-nation (MFN) trading status from Serbia and I invite you to join me as an original cosponsor.

The situation today in Bosnia-Hercegovina is a disgrace and the blame for the bloody conflict must be placed squarely at the doorstep of the Serbian forces of Slobodan Milosevic. As we have watched the Serbian forces on their rampage in Croatia, they are continuing their brutal aggression in Bosnia where thousands of innocent civilians are without homes, and thousands of others are wounded, missing, or dead. The Serbian forces now are systematically destroying the newly independent republic of Bosnia-Hercegovina.

Because of Serbia's total disregard for the legitimate government of Bosnia and the human rights of the people there, Serbia doesn't deserve the special trade treatment for its products offered through MFN status. The House of Representatives forcefully spoke several years ago on the MFN issue when we witnessed the brutal Ceaucescu regime in Romania. We pulled the plug then on Romania and it's time now to do the same with Serbia.
